Monte Antico was founded in 1977 by Neil and Maria Empson as a dedication to their love of Tuscany. Franco Bernabei, a longtime friend of the Empsons, acts as the winemaker and works with the Empsons to style the wine, which is a blend of Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon, and Merlot.
