The fruit was harvested in the cool of the early morning, gently pressed and the juice separated and cold settled before undergoing a steady fermentation at cold temperatures for two weeks. The resulting wine was then stabilized to industry standards, filtered and bottled in a dry style with seamless residual sugar. The generous fruit concentration and fruit sweetness is just one of its highlights.
