### The Wine

Pale straw in colour with fresh aromas of citrus and light floral notes. The wine has a fleshy softness and abundant fruit flavours reminiscent of tropical and citrus fruits with some herbaceous notes. A unique wine that will spark interest and intrigue.

### The Grapes

The grape variety is new to Australia but has long been grown in the Rueda region of northern Spain. Our vines were planted in 2011 and this is the first wine to be made from these vines and the first to be released in Australia.

### The Winemaking

Once harvested the fruit was crushed and pressed with the juice cold settled and racked to ferment. The ferment was carried out with selected yeast and fermented to dryness. Post fermentation the wine was stabilised, clarified and bottled.

### With Food

Enjoy with an antipasto platter or light chicken and fish dishes.
